- In 2016 American Pilgrims on the Camino was pleased to make the following awards, providing \$46,525 in funds to support the Camino in Spain.
- Asociación de Amigos del Camino de Santiago de la Comunidad Valenciana received \$6,000 for marking the Camino Levante in Castilla y León.
- **Asociación Jacobea de Almeria-Camino Mozárabe** received \$6,000 for marking of the Camino Mozárabe throughout the Province of Jaén using granite marker stones.
- Les amis du chemin de St. Jacques en Pyrénées Atlantiques in St. Jean Pied-de-Port received \$6,000 toward the construction of an albergue in Bayonne, France.
- Asociación de Amigos del Camino de Santiago en Cádiz received \$6,000 for marking the route from Cádiz to Sevilla following the ancient "Vía Augusta" using a combination of stone markers, typical Andalusian colored tiles and metallic signs.
